



Dear Parents,

Welcome back. I hope you have all had a delightful summer break. Without a doubt, the weather certainly helps so the holidays seem to have flown by this year as the sunshine has meant we can get out and about a lot more. Teachers have been back for just over a week and although it is lovely to be back with the children and in the school routine, summer already seems like a distant memory. When we first returned on 1st September, we found ourselves discussing Christmas and Easter amongst other things which was quite surreal! The majority of key diary dates for the forthcoming academic year have been organised but a few are awaiting confirmation therefore I have attached the key dates until October to get you started and will publish the full list next week.

THE CHILDREN'S WEEK

Class 1: Reception have settled in very well and have been busy writing rainbow names, looking carefully at eye and hair colour and painting paper plate faces. We have been counting and ordering numbers and enjoying lots of stories. Year 1 have also been exploring the geography of the school. They have photographed different journeys and ordered photos. They have drawn maps of the school and labelled them.

Class 2 have had a very enthusiastic start to the year. We have been explorers; discovering all the hidden places around the school. We have used aerial maps, photographs and floor plans to navigate different pathways.

Class 3: What a fantastic start to the school year, I am really impressed with the transition made by year 3 into Key Stage 2. We have already begun to learn about a wide range of new topics including; Number sense in Maths, Meerkat Mail in Literacy and our thematic topic of "How do we see? How do we hear?" Within our thematic topic we had a letter from Edi who needs our help to get to sleep in the day time, due to working nights. The children have already thought about some fantastic ideas on how Edi can keep the light/sound out of his room.

Class 4 - Miss Randall: We have been working on our new topics in Maths and Literacy. In Literacy the children have completed their elicitation task, started a new topic, 'Truth, Myths and Legends', where they are building up to writing a story about dragons. The children have completed their elicitation task for their new Maths topic of place value.

Class 4 - Mr Evans: We have started our space topic - 'What's out there?' We have begun to consider the difficulties of travelling in space and made log books to solve these problems. Year 6 have been studying science fiction and have focussed on the Iron Man by Ted Hughes. They have also been looking at place value with decimals.
