## THE CHILDREN'S WEEK

**Class 1:** What a great start to the year. The Reception children have settled in beautifully exploring their new learning environment and have got used to school routines. Year 1 have started working on their 'jobs to do'. These are independent challenges that the children have to complete during the week in addition to class inputs and teacher led sessions. I have been very impressed with the maturity and self-organisation that they have shown in completing these tasks. All the children have spent time completing beginning of year assessment tasks.

**Class 2:** Class 2 has had an amazing start to the new school year. The children seem to have had a lovely summer break and it is great to have them back in school.

This year we are trying a new system of working and we are very excited about it. The children are learning through their own investigations; providing them with the opportunity to move their learning forward at a level that is appropriate for them. We are extending the children's independent learning into the outdoors to ensure that children are provided with every opportunity to achieve every day.

**Class 3:** What a fantastic start to the school year, I am really impressed with the transition made by year 3 into Key Stage 2. The year has started with a bang, and we've already completed our assessments in both reading and Maths. The children were brilliant and worked extremely hard! We have also begun our thematic topic of 'Pole to Pole'. The children have already thought about some fantastic ideas about what they would like to learn.

**Class 4:** This week has been all about settling in, learning new routines and expectations. I have been impressed with the level of contribution and the discussions around our topic 'Incredible Journeys' have been excellent. In English the children have been developing their descriptive skills; using expanded noun phrases and varying their sentence openers. In Maths, the children have been reading, writing and positioning numbers to one million.
