Using our locality

The school grounds
Paignton Zoo

Science:

- Do we have paws, claws and whiskers? – learn about human body parts and senses and compare to other animals.
- Pets – what are they like, how do we look after them?
- Paignton zoo trip – compare animals with pets – dogs and wolves, cats and tigers.
- Identify and name common animals – how can we sort them?
- Animal body parts – how do animals move/eat/ sense?
- What do animals eat? Introduce terms herbivore, carnivore & omnivore.
- Animal coverings – skin, fur & feather – link to camouflage.

COMPUTING:

- E-safety
- Log on as a user
- Practise Literacy and Maths skills
- Produce pictures/text and begin to save with support.

MATHS:

Place value

- Counting and writing numbers
- Finding one more/one less
- Comparing numbers – introducing $>$ $<$
- Ordering numbers and ordinal numbers, 1st, 2nd, 3rd...
- Addition including recording as number sentences and systematic methods for finding number bonds
- Subtraction recording as number sentences, taking away and finding the difference
- Showing numbers in tens and ones
- Writing numbers to 20 in numerals and words

Geometry

- Recognise and name 2d and 3d shapes
- Sort 2d and 3d shapes
- Use shapes to create patterns.

Humanities:

- **Geography** – where do animals live in the wild? Link to the continents and oceans.
- **History** – The Gunpowder Plot – who was Guy Fawkes? Armistice – 100 years since the end of WW1
