

Literacy Through shared reading and writing we will focus on developing information texts and recounts. We will use the language and features of non-fiction texts to make class books and brochures. The children will investigate the generic structure of recounts and be aware of the importance of the order of events. They will produce simple accounts and information texts, based on their own experiences and on the events leading up to the Queen's birthday.

All About God

In this unit children draw upon their own understanding of belonging, and then relate this to what Christians understand about belonging. They think about how people show they belong and what is special about belonging. There is opportunity to provide an introduction to belonging within the context of Judaism. Work in this unit will enable children to explore symbols important to believers within Christianity and Judaism.



Science Year 1 are looking at Seasonal Changes for the first part of the term We will find out and describe the movement of the sun and weather patterns.

Year 2 are investigating Living Things including animals and their habitats.

Both classes will then be exploring Materials and their properties.

Numeracy We will continue to work out fractions of objects and numbers and explore halving and doubling numbers. We will begin to learn about division and how to share and divide quantities whilst using our knowledge of times tables. We will work on recognising the link between division and multiplication to help us solve calculations. We will explore methods for solving problems using multiplication and division in a real life context.

KS1's Learning Map for the Summer Term 'Journeys'

Art and Design In D and T the children will design and build a form of London transport as part of their family learning. We will be looking at design of Tudor buildings and the work of the architect Sir Christopher Wren.

I.T

The children will be working towards being able to type with two hands. The children will be taught how to use shift, space and enter correctly. We will learn how to make text bold, italic or underline it. We will be saving our work in a folder and using it to make a poster about London.

Humanities We will be looking at the geography of the city of London and comparing it with Beer. In the history aspect we will be looking at the events of the Great Fire of London. As a special study, we will be learning about the Royal Family, leading up to the celebrations of the Queen's birthday.

P.E.

We will practise running, jumping and ball skills and move into simple team activities in preparation for Sports Day.

Music and Drama The children will learn traditional 'London' songs and dances. We will be acting out the drama of the Fire of London.

P.S.H.E. In our Relationships topic we will be learning how to understand and manage feelings, both of ourselves and others. We will then be reflecting on Changes for the transitions of the coming September.
